4.3. FTIP Update

Agustin Barajas, SCAG, reported the following:

- 2025 FTIP Amendment #25-03 was approved by FHWA and FTA on March 18, 2025, and 2025 FTIP Amendment #25-04 was approved by SCAG on March 13, 2025.
- 2025 FTIP Amendment #25-05 was expected to be approved at the end of March 2025.
- 2025 FTIP Amendment #25-06 was expected to be released for public review early April 2025.
- Future opportunities for projects modifications included 2025 FTIP Amendment #25-07 with submissions due to SCAG on April 15, 2025.
- Additionally, SCAG would begin the STBG and CMAQ programs calls for project nominations on March 31, 2025.
 The guidelines for the programs were approved by SCAG Regional Council on March 6, 2025, and SCAG held two workshops on March 19 and March 24, 2025, as well as individual workshops with each County Transportation Commission. The programs would involve discretionary funding in federal fiscal years 2026/2027 and 2027/2028.

4.5. CARB Update

Nesamani Kalandiyur, CARB, reported the following:

• CARB staff expected to finalize the EMFAC202Y model in March 2025 and planned a public workshop for April 2025. CARB would share the EMFAC202Y model once it became available.
